

PROHIBITED AND RESTRICTED ITEMS >

FOR TRANSBORDER SHIPMENTS

PROHIBITED:

- » Alcohol/Spirits/Beer/Wine Licensing and excise restrictions apply.
- » Animals/Fish Includes mounted, stuffed or other processed animal products.
- » Carbon Black Prohibited as a manufacturing colorant.
- » Coins or Currency Not permitted.
- » Collections Includes stamps, coins, cards, etc.
- » Dangerous Goods Class 6, Class 2.3 and Class 1 items (except Class 1.4) are restricted.
- » Firearms/Ammunition Restricted due to licensing issues.
- » Hazardous Waste All classes from 1–9 are prohibited.
- » High-Value Shipments No increased valuation for transborder shipments. Items valued over \$5 per pound must be removed from the BOL prior to transit; increased coverage is available only through tariffs.
- » Human Remains/Ashes/Parts Includes cadavers and similar materials for scientific purposes.
- » Infectious Substances Class 6 items are restricted.
- » Jewelry/Precious Gems/Metals Only costume jewelry without a declared value is acceptable.
- » Live Plants Prohibited in LTL quantities.
- » Marijuana Includes plants, seeds and related items.
- » Motor Vehicles Motorcycles, ATVs, scooters, trailers, snowmobiles, cars, trucks, boats and other vehicles subject to US or Canadian DOT import/export requirements are prohibited.
- » Negotiable Instruments Any document guaranteeing a specific payment, such as a check, is prohibited.
- » Nitrocellulose (guncotton) Class 3 and Class 4.1 are restricted.
- » Tobacco or Tobacco Products Excise restrictions apply.

RESTRICTED:

- » Artwork, Antiques and Statues Shipped with zero declared value only.
- » Explosives Only Class 1.4 explosives can be moved across the border.
- » Granite, Marble and Glass sheets Must be crated and able to stand independently.
- » Liftgate/Power Tailgate Service Restricted to the rated capacity of the liftgate (typically 2,500 lbs.), subject to dimension limitations.
- » Personal Household Goods Moved at the shipper's risk of loss or damage, with no declared value. Used mattresses are excluded. A detailed inventory is required and all southbound shipments must clear on PAPS.
- » Radioactive Materials (Class 7) Only nonplacard able amounts can be shipped, with packaging deemed "excepted" per 14.38 of the regulations (e.g., smoke detectors, survey equipment).
- » Temperature-Controlled Shipments "Protect from freezing" service is available in winter; ambient temperature service is unavailable for LTL shipments.
- » TIB, Carnet or E29B Shipments Require advance notification and approval through National Transborder. Not all gateways or crossings are available, which may add days to transit time. Additional driver stop charges may apply.
- » Trade Show Shipments Accepted only when moving to an off-site warehouse or staging area. We do not deliver directly to convention venues.
